ANNUAL PARKING PERMIT FEES

A vehicle with a current Town of Boonton annual parking permit may park in any parking space regulated by a long-term parking meter or coin slot box in any town toll parking lot or on any public street designated as a long-term parking meter zone. A "long-term parking meter" shall mean a metered parking space in which it is legal to park for three hours or more. Permit must be hung from rear view mirror when parking.:

Annual parking permits may be obtained by the Town Clerk. The fee for an annual permit shall be \$175, which shall be prorated for a partial calendar year. Each annual permit must be displayed by suspending it from the vehicle's inside rear view mirror so that the permit can be seen readily from outside the vehicle. Permits that have been lost or stolen may be replaced for a fixed charge of \$25.00. All lost permits MUST be reported to the Boonton Police Department in order to obtain a replacement.

Parking permitted ONLY at a designated LONG TERM space available at Meters offering 3 - 9 hours OR parking lots controlled by coin box. Parking Permits MUST be displayed from the rear view mirror in order to be valid

MAIN STREET - BUSINESS DISTRICT

Parking on Main Street between Myrtle and Hill Streets is free of charge for two hours. Enforcement is monitored by tire chalking. Refer to the green signs posted on Main Street for details

PARKING LOTS - Locations & Descriptions

- * **Upper Plane Street** - Located parallel to Main Street on its northwesterly side. All day parking is available using the coin box at the entrance of the lot. Annual permit holders may continue to park the entire day in the long-term area.
- * **American Legion** - Located behind the American Legion Hall (John Taylor Building) adjacent to Route 287's Southbound Access Road. Geared towards commuters
- * **Kiwanis** - Located adjacent to the Kiwanis Club Building on Lathrop Avenue. Geared towards commuters.
- * **Bider Lot** - Located on Cornelia Street, adjacent to the Elks Building, 2-hour and 9-hour metered parking spaces are available
- * **SIDE STREET PARKING** (Off Main Street)
