

**TOWN OF BOONTON
ORDINANCE 01-10**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF BOONTON FIXING THE SALARIES AND WAGES OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWN OF BOONTON, COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, FOR THE YEAR 2010

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Boonton, New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Salaries and wages for employees of the Town of Boonton for the year 2009 are hereby established as follows:

Salaries of all other employees of the Town of Boonton who are not referred to in this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect until otherwise modified.

Section 2. Longevity

(a) In addition to the above salaries, full time employees of the Town of Boonton whose contract specifically so provides shall be paid a longevity payment according to the schedule listed therein.

(b) Additional compensation of any nature, including overtime willnot be considered in computing longevity.

Section 3. In addition to the above salaries for full-time employees, Public Works employees who qualify shall receive additional pay for their respective licenses as indicated in their current collective bargaining contract.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication as required by law.
