ORDINANCE 10-11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF BOONTON FIXING THE SALARIES AND WAGES OF POLICE DEPARTMENT SUPERIOR OFFICERS OF THE TOWN OF BOONTON, COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, FOR THE YEAR 2009-2012

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Boonton, New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. Salaries and wages for superior officers of the Town of Boonton for the year 2009-2012 are hereby established as follows:

Salaries of all other employees of the Town of Boonton who are not referred to in this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect until otherwise modified.

Section 2. Longevity

(a) In addition to the above salaries, full time employees of the Town of Boonton whose contract specifically so provides shall be paid a longevity payment according to the schedule listed therein.

(b) Additional compensation of any nature, including overtime will not be considered in computing longevity.

Section 3. Sworn officers of the Town Police Department shall be paid holiday pay in accordance with the controlling collectively bargained contract.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication as required by law.

The foregoing ordinance having been introduced and passed on first reading by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Boonton, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, on May 2, 2011 then ordered to be published according to law, will be further considered for final passage and adoption at a public hearing to be held at a meeting beginning at 7:30 p.m. on May 16, 2011 at the Town Hall, 100 Washington Street, Boonton, NJ 07005, when and where, or at such time and place to which said meeting may be adjourned. All persons interested will be given an opportunity to be heard concerning said ordinance.
