IMPORTANT MESSAGE TO BOONTON RESIDENTS & MERCHANTS

On Saturday, Sept. 4 2010 the Boonton Fire Department will hold their annual Labor Day Parade beginning at 1:30PM. **All of MAIN STREET , PLANE STREET**, the 100 & 200 Blocks of WASHINGTON STREET, the 100, 200 & 300 blocks of GRANT STREET, OLD BOONTON ROAD and, LATHROP AVE will be closed from 1:00PM to approximately 5:00PM for the Parade. **PARKING along the streets described above will be prohibited from 12:15 PM until after the Parade.**

All Streets in the **PARK SECTION** including Chestnut, River and Lake, will be utilized to stage the Parade Apparatus and Marchers. **Essex Avenue at W. Main Street will be CLOSED to south bound traffic from, 11:00AM until the Parade is completed.** PARKING will also be prohibited on these streets. Residents are asked to utilize off street parking for their vehicles. **The streets listed below will not be closed but,** will have a barricade with detour signs at the following locations. This is to discourage unnecessary traffic in the Park Section. Fanny Road on Morris Avenue, Fanny Road on Puddingstone Drive, Fanny Road on Essex Avenue, W. Main Street on Ely Street, W. Main Street on Chestnut Street, W. Main Street on Lake Avenue. Residents and Visitors can carefully drive around these barricades and travel to their destination **in the Park Section.**

Exit # 44 from 287 North will be closed from approximately 11:00AM until the completion of the Parade. The DETOUR ROUTE for this and the Main Street closure is as follows: Use Exit # 45 onto Park Avenue, onto Wootton Street, onto Division onto Boonton Avenue, onto Cedar Street, onto Highland Avenue and onto W. Main Street at Pond Bridge. W. Main Street from N. Main to Del's Village will remain OPEN. Access to 287 South will be available by using Myrtle Avenue. To facilitate safe and orderly flow of traffic on the detour route, PARKING will be prohibited on the ODD NUMBERED side of Highland, the EVEN NUMBERED side of Cedar and the ODD NUMBERED side of Boonton Avenue.

ATTENTION RESIDENTS on the 100, 200 and 300 blocks of Monroe Street. and Lathrop Avenue. The 100 and 200 blocks of Madison and Holmes Streets, and the residents of Maple Avenue. To Enter and Exit your Streets during the Parade, you must cross the Parade Route at **Holmes and Grant Streets ONLY.** Police personnel will be located there to facilitate safe and orderly crossing. Residents of Monroe, Grant & Lincoln Sts. south of Washington St. will have to Exit and Enter their Streets via Harrison Street.
