

## 2009 Program Descriptions

### **Boonton Recreation Camp**

An opportunity for Boonton children, ages 4 – 12, to enjoy their summer vacation with their friends while participating in supervised games, activities, events and challenges. Children are grouped by age and follow a daily camp schedule. Children are supervised within their group by a Group Leader (A recent high school graduate or college student) with support from high school and middle school students. In addition, the camp has a full time Camp Director, Sports Director and Activities Coordinator. Camp is available as a morning option: 9AM – 12Noon, or a full day option: 9AM – 2PM.

### **L.I.T. Program- New for 2009**

Leaders In Training - For Boonton teens currently in grades 7 & 8. Teens participate in events and activities, are taught a variety of games and team-building exercises, and will have an opportunity to develop leadership skills while assisting group leaders throughout the camp. The L.I.T. program is available on a weekly basis from 9AM – 2PM. LIT Contract of Agreement must accompany registration form.

### **Enrichment**

A series of programs designed to provide a fun summer experience while offering programs in a classroom setting. Each class is staffed by a certified teacher. Enrichment programs are offered each week 8:30AM – 12Noon. Enrichment participants are welcome to register for afternoon camp (12Noon – 2PM).

### **Theater Workshop**

Offered as an afternoon enrichment program, this one week workshop is designed to improve participants' life skills through the use of fun and challenging acting exercises. Children will be taught acting with a focus on improvisation, concentration and relaxation. Through these tools, actors learn to be more self-confident, trusting, outgoing and comfortable in group situations. Offered by Actor's Garage, this program is available **week 1 only 12PM – 2PM**.

### **Chess Workshop**

A one week afternoon workshop designed as an introduction to the exciting world of chess. Participation will foster critical, creative, and original thinking through the game of chess. Each participant will learn the pieces, basic opening moves, castling, tactics, puzzles and more. Instruction by a USCD certified instructor, this program is available **week 3 only 12PM – 2PM**.

### **Musical Instrument Lessons**

Join High School Music Teacher Alan Masters for musical instrument lessons. Open to children currently in grades 3, 4 and 5. Lesson times will be determined at a later date, based upon enrollment. Lessons will be held half hour/day, two times per week for 6 weeks. You must provide your own instrument.
