

2010 Program Descriptions

Summer Camp Program

Program is held Monday – Friday at John Hill School. Program is open to **Town of Boonton Residents** in Pre-K 4 – 6th grade- (minimum age is 4) Children are grouped by age and separated into groups based on current grade level. Camp is offered as a morning option (9AM – 12PM), as a full day option (9AM – 2PM) or as an afternoon option in conjunction with the morning Enrichment (12PM – 2PM). Morning campers do not participate in afternoon events and afternoon campers may not come early to attend morning events. Lunch break is taken every day at 11:30AM. Campers are asked to pack a brown bag lunch each day, except on special event free lunch days, when lunch will be provided.

Enrichment Program-8:30AM – 12:00PM

This program is held Monday – Friday at John Hill School, and is staffed by certified teachers. Program is open to children who have **completed** grades K – 6. Open to Boonton and non- Boonton residents. Although some programs are repeated, the program will change each week, so feel free to register for the same class different weeks.

L.I.T. Program

Leaders In Training - For Boonton teens currently in grades 7 & 8. Teens participate in events and activities, are taught a variety of games and team-building exercises, and will have an opportunity to develop leadership skills while assisting group leaders throughout the camp. The L.I.T. program is available on a weekly basis from 9AM – 2PM. LIT Contract of Agreement must accompany registration form.

After Camp Care 2PM – 5PM

After Care is available from camp dismissal until 5pm and is held at John Hill School. This service is provide by Cedar Hill Community Development Corporation and is not associated with Boonton Parks and Recreation.

General Rules and Regulations

1. Registrations are processed strictly in the order in which they are received.
2. All tuition must accompany the registration form.
3. All registrations are due by June 15, 2010
4. Any cancellations must be received before June 21st to avoid a cancellation fee of \$25 per person.
5. Each child must be registered on a separate form (photocopies will be accepted.)
6. Sibling Discount of 20% applies to each additional child in household. First child pays full price.
7. Enrichment programs have a minimum enrollment of 8 students/class.
8. You will be contacted if a class has to be canceled or substituted.
9. Any child who requires constant disciplinary attention will not be able to continue in the program and will be dismissed **without a refund**.
10. There will be no refunds or make ups for any missed days or expulsion.
11. Submission of the registration form gives consent to include your child in media events related to the program.
12. In case of severe inclement weather or other unforeseen emergency, we reserve the right to cancel activities without refund or make-up.
