


The VOTER REGISTRATION deadline for the General Election is Tuesday, October 13.



How do I register to vote?

First, check the State of New Jersey's Elections ["Am I registered?" page](#) to see if you're already registered.

If you are not registered you can either:

- [Register to vote online](#) (a driver's license/non-driver ID card OR a Social Security number is required)
- Or, complete a registration application form at the Morris County Board of Elections' office or by mail:

The voter registration deadline for the General Election is Tuesday, October 13. Completed voter registration applications can be mailed or delivered in person and deposited in the drop-off box available in the Lobby of the Administration & Records Building located at 10 Court Street, Morristown. Forms are also available at any Municipal Clerk's office, through the League of Women Voters, or other public agencies.
