RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF BOONTON TO PURCHASE FIREFIGHTER PROTECTIVE CLOTHING & EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, the Town of Boonton may by resolution, and without advertising for bids or obtaining quotations, purchase any goods or services under a Cooperative Pricing Council; and

WHEREAS, the Town has the need on a timely basis to purchase goods and services utilizing a Cooperative Pricing Council for firefighter protective clothing & equipment for the Boonton Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the Town intends to enter into contract for firefighter clothing:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Alderman of the Town of Boonton, authorizes the Qualified Purchasing Agent to purchase certain goods and services from the New Jersey State Contract Fire-Dex T-0790, (17DPP00100), pursuant to all conditions of the individual contracts; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Boonton, pursuant to NJAC 5:30-5.5(b) (the certification of available funds), states that the Chief Finance Officer shall either certify the full maximum amount against the budget at the time the contract is awarded, or no contract amount shall be chargeable or certified until such time as the goods or services are ordered or otherwise called for prior to placing the order, and a certification of availability of funds is made by the Chief Finance Officer; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption according to law.
