REQUIREMENTS

The property owner will be required to provide insurance coverage indemnifying the Town against any claims or losses in connection with the sidewalk or curb replacement work to be done. A certificate of such insurance must be filed with the Town Clerk prior to any work commenced.

If address is on a County road, a County road-opening permit will be needed: Tel. No. 973-285-6749. Copy of permit to be attached to sidewalk permit.

- A. Arrangement with DPW - 973-402-9460 (Michael Petonak, DPW Superintendent)
- B. Inspection before pouring
- C. Concrete must be Class "B" Air Entrained (6" at driveways) 4" thick 3000 psi
Dense graded aggregate base course 4" thick. Compacted sub-grade.
- D. Curbs must be 12" underground, 6" wide, 6" above road. Expansion 8' minimum
Must have expansion between curb and sidewalk, if together.
- E. Contractor must patch all paved areas that were disturbed.
- F. Areas between curb and sidewalk must be top soiled to grade and seed planted for grass.
- G. When contractor starts job, he will be responsible for the safety of pedestrians and vehicles. All safety appliances will be supplied by contractor.
- H. Sidewalk and curb must be constructed in accordance with these specifications within 30 days of removal.
