RESOLUTION 21-252

RESOLUTION AWARDING CONTRACT FOR BASKETBALL COURT RENOVATIONS AT PEPE FIELD TO JAG PAVING CORPORATION

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Boonton have heretofore received plans and specifications constituting a public bid package from the Town Engineer, Mott MacDonald for said project; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Town Council have heretofore approved said public bid package, as prepared by Town Engineer, and directed the Town Clerk to publicly advertise for bids; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Boonton received two (2) bids for said project on Wednesday, September 15, 2021 at the Town of Boonton Municipal Building; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq., requires that competitive bidding contracts be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, review of the two (2) received bids identified JAG Paving Corporation as the lowest apparent responsive, responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, the Town Attorney has reviewed the bid from JAG Paving Corporation and found it to be in proper form and in compliance with the requirements of the Local Public Contract Law, and has deemed it responsible and responsive (see attached as "Exhibit A"); and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available for this contract.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and council of the Town of Boonton, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Boonton, upon the recommendation of the Town Engineer and as reviewed by the Town Attorney, hereby award a contract for Basketball Court Renovations at Pepe Field to the lowest responsible bidder, JAG Paving Corporation, 220 Kearny Avenue, Kearny, NJ 07032, for the Base Bid sum of Ninety-Four Thousand Dollars (\$94,000.00).
2. The Mayor and Town Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute said contract.

3. This resolution and contract shall be available for public inspection in the officer of the Town Clerk.
4. This Resolution Shall take effect immediately.
