RESOLUTION 21-249

AUTHORIZING TAX SALE PURSUANT TO EXECUTIVE ORDER 190

WHEREAS, on October 15, 2020, Governor Murphy issued Executive Order 190 which, among other things, requires that *“No gas or electric public or municipal utility or privately or publicly owned water system shall collect any fee or charge imposed for late or otherwise untimely payments or service reconnections that have accrued, and will continue to accrue, during the Public Health Emergency”*;

WHEREAS, the Town shall conduct an upcoming tax sale on October 6, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Collector has determined that in order to fully comply with the requirements of Executive Order 190, the Town should not sell any water/sewer delinquencies at the October 6, 2021 tax sale.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Boonton, New Jersey, that the Tax Collector shall proceed with the October 6, 2021 tax sale but not sell any water/sewer delinquencies at said tax sale in order to fully comply with Executive Order 190.
