**RESOLUTION 22-193**

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF BOONTON, COUNTY OF MORRIS AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN INTERLOCAL SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE BOROUGH OF MOUNTAIN LAKES FOR WATER SERVICE AND ENFORCEMENT OF LIENS FOR UNPAID CHARGES**

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:31-23 authorizes a municipality to provide water and sewer services to properties in another municipality with the consent of both municipalities; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:31-12 provides for a lien on real property serviced by municipal water systems for fees and charges incurred without regard to the location of the real property being serviced; and

**WHEREAS**, water and sewer services for users in certain locations in the Borough of Mountain Lakes have been historically provided by the Town of Boonton; and

**WHEREAS**, it is appropriate for the municipalities to enter into an agreement to confirm the consent to service these properties and for the procedure to impose tax liens; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Mountain Lakes recently authorized execution of the subject agreement, by Resolution 130-22, attached at "Exhibit A."

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Boonton, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. That the appropriate municipal officials are hereby authorized to execute the Agreement between the Town of Boonton and the Borough of Mountain Lakes, confirming consent of the Borough of Mountain Lakes for Water and Sewer Service provided by the Town of Boonton to certain properties located in the Borough of Mountain Lakes and Establishing a Procedure for Enforcement of Liens and Unpaid Charges in the form attached hereto.
2. The appropriate municipal officials are hereby authorized and directed to take any further actions as necessary to further the intent and purpose of the agreement.
3. This Resolution and Agreement shall be available for public inspection in the office of the Town Clerk.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
